

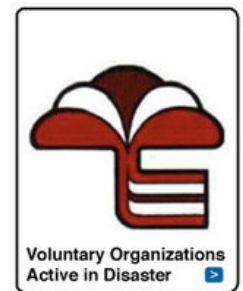
Essential Services

- From PNP Program Legislation

“Providing governmental type services to the community affected by an emergency or disaster, through the distribution of supplies and other disaster or emergency assistance activities.

Private Nonprofit (PNP) activities are those that provide essential services including but not limited to food, water and shelter.”

Title 19. Division 2. Chapter 6. Disaster Assistance Act. Article 2.



Essential Services (2)

- Direct services, including but not limited to:
 - Water, food, shelter
 - Other supplies
- Must be asked for by jurisdiction
- Must be a resource the jurisdiction does not have
- Must relate to the disaster



Essential Services (3)

- Real-world experience
 - Orange County/Operation OC
 - Coordination of debris removal services and food for volunteers
 - Drought
 - Water services to households for drinking and sanitation
 - Valley Fire/Sonoma 211
 - Information to callers on disaster and disaster-related resources and services
